CIlr RH CDK Moving safely around Linden

Council notes RMS rules do not allow 40km here but Warrimoo zoning indicates it may be a possibility. Council proposes Glossop Rd as a pilot and review. Council is sending report to Local Traffic Committee. RH wishes to see the report endorsed by them, particularly NSW Police. RH also suggest writing to Hon Melinda Pavey to see how receptive the minister is. Trish Doyle MP also being contacted about changing the guidelines for 40km zones. Counsellors felt this was an innovative way to pursue changes in increasing pedestrian safety around the mountains. TD is happy to meet with LCA and increase media pressure to continue pursuing the changes. Jon suggested 9am Sat-
